2 · Agreed authorship framework

- ☐ Each qualifying submitter author above the included limit adds USD 150; Colombian projects are billed in the COP equivalent.
- ☐ microscopIA reserves the final four positions for qualifying microscopIA contributors and designates the corresponding author to coordinate the editorial pathway.
- ☐ Payment, enrolment, supervision, employment, status, or access never buys authorship. Every named person must meet the target journal's criteria.
- ☐ Journal limits and policies control. If they require a different order or fewer authors, the parties must document and approve the compliant revision before submission.
